Warm & Comforting Butternut Squash Soup

Prep the squash: Peel, deseed, and chop the butternut squash into cubes.

Roast or sauté: Either roast the cubes in the oven with a little oil (olive oil works well) at 400°F for about 25-30 minutes until tender, or sauté them in a pan with some oil over medium heat for 10-15 minutes.

Season: Add your preferred spices – a pinch of salt, pepper, garlic, and maybe a touch of cinnamon or nutmeg.

Blend or mash: Once cooked, either blend it up for a smooth puree or mash it for a chunkier texture.

Finish: Add a splash of vegetable broth or water if you want a smoother consistency. Taste and adjust seasoning if needed.
